



Landscaper and Garden Coordinator Fanjoy's Junior Chef Community Garden Program

Part Time Contract April – September 2022

30 hrs/week \$18.10/hr - \$22/hr

- design and create a teaching garden onsite for our culinary Junior Chef + Life skills programs that includes vegetables and floral gardens in a sustainable eco-system
- create a comprehensive written and visual manual for the procedures of the annual maintenance, rotation of crops and health of the garden and property landscaping needs
- create a teaching program, including power point presentations for the purpose of delivering the information to our culinary students and volunteers
- maintain the shrubs, fruit trees, hedges, gardens and soil conditions of our organic property, making recommendations for improvements
- build and construct trellis' and other functional and ornamental structures that will support the vegetables, annuals, vines, trees, organic grapes and hops on the property
- develop and track water usage for sustainable systems for watering our plants, inside and outside then provide training to volunteers who can maintain this as needed
- provide staff, volunteers and junior chefs with engaging educational opportunities to learn about agriculture, food, sustainability and eco-friendly everyday practices
- to initiate and nourish strategic partnerships with University of Guelph, local farmers and other stakeholders that will strengthen our culinary program offerings and facilitate the building of our culinary studio in 2022-2023.
- harvest produce and work with interdisciplinary team to ensure culinary education, programming and food waste targets
- prepare entire property for wintering (Sept/October)
