### **JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- conduct psychosocial assessments, then develop client centred, effective treatment plans in collaboration with the client to deliver evidence based, inclusive, feminist oriented counselling that support living more joyful lives sustainably with transitional aged youth, 14-29 and their families.
  - Participate hands on in the kitchen to deliver Fanjoy's Junior Chef interactive Culinary Fundamentals and Culinary Classics + Life Skills programs, engage in assisting with the Company's food insecurity initiatives, and Our Food Futures projects
  - collaborate with community food partners, nutritional or farm educational programs to further develop new programs for the youth that we serve
  - engage in research and tracking impact measurement of Fanjoy's innovative culinary counselling model
  - take a leadership role in evaluating and implementing a new restaurant/café or Farmer's Market initiative that will provide new opportunities for developing work skills for our Junior Chefs and under privileged or marginalize youth age 16-29 years
  - Develop relevant curriculum for 8 week group programs and present psycho-educational and psycho-dynamic sessions to youth and/or parents in individual or group formats in our new Guelph Culinary & Wellness Centre
  - train, orient and provide a rich learning experience using a mentorship model with our volunteers, junior chefs and students
  - Facilitates youth and/or parent group sessions, alone or as a responsive co-therapist, both in person and/or on ZOOM.
- Must be skilled at using ZOOM, Team Meets, Microsoft Word, and knowledge of Mac programs will be an asset as you demonstrate ease with running the technical aspects of virtual workshops, counselling and/or cooking classes with Chef Pam.

- Assists clients in coordinating alternative outpatient counselling and/or follow-up as needed being particularly attentive to helping clients respond to cracks in our current mental health systems.
